


Holly Jolly Place Cards

Quick to make! Welcome all your guests to the table...even the ones who show up at the last minute!

Skill Level: Beginner 

Time to Complete: 30 minutes

Tools Needed:

- [6" x 12" Non-Slip, Frosted Advantage™ Acrylic Ruler: "The Traveler" \(OR 6 x 12\)](#)
- [12" x 18" Self-Healing Rotary Mat \(RM-CG\)](#)
- [45mm Deluxe Ergonomic Rotary Cutter \(RTY-2/DX\)](#)
- [Rotary Circle Cutter \(CMP-3\)](#)

Materials Needed:

- Double-sided holiday scrapbook cardstock
- Alphabet rubber stamp, Black ink pad, Chalk ink
- Corner rounding tool, Decorative brad
- Fibers, ribbon

Instructions

1. From the card stock, cut one piece 4 ½ x 5", using a decorative blade. Round the corners with a corner rounding tool. Fold in half so it measures 2 ½ x 4 ½".
2. With the circle cutter, cut a 3" circle from cardstock. Fold slightly less than half so that the back side of the card stock shows, forming a small border.
3. Ink all of the edges with chalk color to match or contrast with the cardstock.
4. Stamp a name on the semi-circle.
5. Punch a hole in the center of the semi-circle above the name. Do the same on the place card, ½" down from the folded edge, through one layer only.
6. Use a brad to anchor the semi-circle to the place card.
7. Wrap the stem of the brad with various fibers.
