Take all those fleece scraps and create this fun "no-sew" foldelope - a folded envelope that can be used to hold many different things - from CD's to greeting cards, small gifts, photographs, scissors, even money. The foldelope is easy to make and attractive to use. Have fun decorating your finished project with beautiful ribbons and closures.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time to Complete: 1 Hour

Tools Needed:

- [6" x 12" Non-Slip, Frosted Advantage™ Acrylic Ruler: "The Traveler" \(QR 6 x 12\)](#)
- [6" x 24" Non-Slip, Frosted Advantage™ Acrylic Ruler: "The Essential" \(QR 6 x 24\)](#)
- [24" x 36" Self-Healing Rotary Mat \(RM-MG\)](#)
- [45mm Deluxe Ergonomic Rotary Cutter \(RTY-2/DX\)](#)
- [45mm Rotary Scallop/Peak Blade, 1-pack \(SCB45-1\)](#)

Materials Needed:

- 6 1/2" x 17" Fleece
- Fabric Glue such as FabriTac™
- Assorted ribbons and closures of choice such as Velcro™, snaps, buttons, trims, threads, beads, crystals.

Instructions

1. Cut a 6 1/2" x 17" rectangle of fleece using your OLFA rotary cutter and the scallop blade. Cut both sides, top, and bottom going in the same direction to get the same look all the way around.
2. Fold up bottom 6" of fleece to form the pocket and glue in place using fabric glue.
3. Use the 45 degree angle markings on your OLFA 6" x 12" ruler and your rotary cutter to cut the angle top of your foldelope. Next, embellish! Use the ribbons, buttons, beads, flowers, etc.; be creative!
4. Insert CD, gift, or other object. Secure closed with your choice of trims and ribbons.
